It is brought to the notice of all S. Y. B. Tech/students that Institute had conducted English Proficiency Test on 30th July. Course syllabus, trial test were provided to students and for passing minimum 50% marks condition was kept. In spite of advance information and facilities provided 84 students failed to score more than 50% marks.

The students who scored less than 50% marks in the Proficiency test will have to take up compulsory add-on course on Communication Skills under which the students have to attend 20 Hrs of Sessions as per the contents and appear for test again. Passing proficiency test is compulsory before taking admission to Third Year (5th Semester). No examination fees shall be charged, however students, who take add-on course have to submit registration form to Prof. R. R. Kuntawad (ENTC Department) and pay Rs 280/- to account section and take payment receipt. The registration form is available with Prof. R. R. Kuntawad (ENTC Department) as well as can be downloaded from website.

The registration shall be conformed when the students will submits payment receipt and registration form to Prof. R. R. Kuntawad (ENTC Department).
