1.	Dr. Dabade expressed concern about Course Outcomes and suggest revisions of COs.
2.	Dr. Patil raised concern about implementation of Multi-Disciplinary Minor and its policy.
3	Dr. Sutaone expressed that basic science courses should be designed branch specific.
4	Dr Uday Dabade raised concern about the high number of contact hours in the seven semesters and it was agreed by the program heads that 7 th semester subjects will be adjusted in previous semesters.
5	Dr. Dhote expressed about the implementation policy of MOOC courses
6	Dr. Dabade said the house that while designing curriculum subjects should be included in such a way that curriculum reflects flow.
7	Dr. Patil expressed that the exit courses at various level should be selected in such a way that students exiting at some point should get some job offers.

To note and approve Academic Calendar for 2023-24


Dean Academics presented Academic Calendar for academic year 2023-24 for all UG and PG programs.
