In view of possible discrepancy about degree to be awarded to the students, a representation will be given to the concerned authorities of Shivaji University. In case, if subject of minor is to be mentioned in the degree certificate, house unanimously agreed to mention as EV (Electrical Engineering), EV (Mechanical Engineering) and Image Processing (E&TC). However, if guidelines of Shivaji University remain to mention the department name as the subject of minor, house resolved to either mention minor names as Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering and Electronics and Telecommunication respectively or any other suitable as per the representation of APEC.


