Member Secretary presented the details of activities of ESE winter 2018 Examination.

- Member Secretary presented the result analysis of the winter 2018 examination showing the percentage of passing and failure.
- Member Secretary also informed to the house that the Grade moderation for UG programs are done as per the rules based on relative grading system given in ordinance, rules and regulation of autonomy while PG programs it is based on absolute grading system.
- Prof. Kakade has expressed his deep concern regarding higher % failure of fifth semester MCA and F.Y B.Tech students.
- After discussion for the reasons of failure of fifth semester MCA students in professional communication, Prof. Kakade and Dr. S.S. Dambhare strongly recommended to conduct re examination of the subject, and result of the examination should be communicated to all members of examination committee.
- Regarding the higher % of failure of F.Y B.Tech students in Mathematics Graphics, Basic civil engineering and Basic electronics and computer engineering, the respective subject coordinators were asked to remain present in meeting. After discussion on higher % of failure , Hon. Chairman instructed the subject

coordinators to take remedial measures in future to improve overall result of the respective subject.

- Dr. S.S. Damhare suggested and stressed to carryout academic audit.

With the above suggestions the house approved post facto approval to declare the results of winter 2018 ESE Examination.

- Hon. Chairman, instructed to member secretary and assessment coordinators to implement the above suggestion as a pilot project to the all first year of B.Tech/M.Tech and MCA in coming ESE Exam.
- Prof. Kakade informed the house about revised exam remuneration rate of Shivaji University. Hon. Chairman, suggested implementing it with immediate effect with certain modification to our system.
