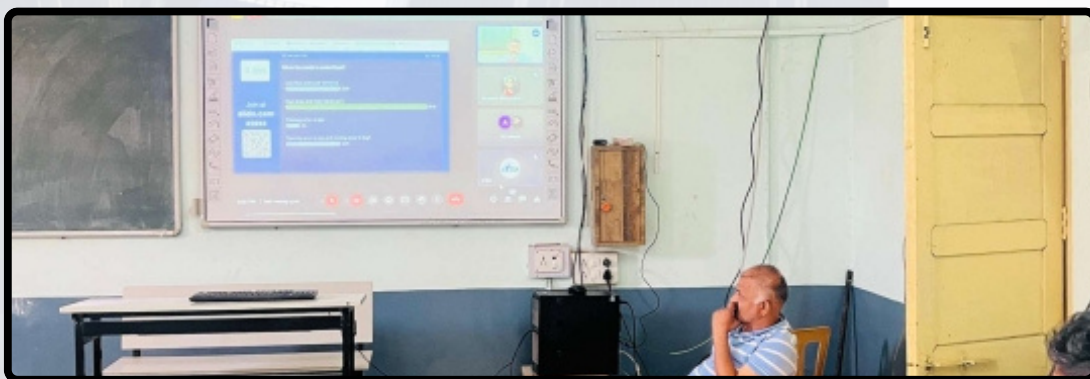
TECHQUEST
