Hon. Chairman presented and discussed following models of Quality Assessment

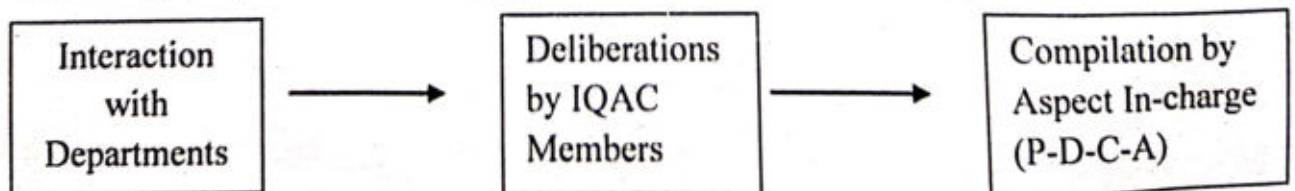

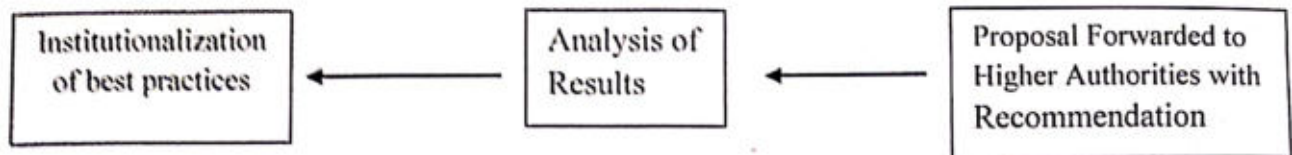
- Hon. Chairman proposed that IQAC of Government College of Engineering shall follow Barnet model with the notion of Kaizen model.

### **Item No. 9.5**

#### **To discuss various modalities to promote Research and Development in the Institution**

Dr. A.T. Pise proposed following reforms to promote Research and Development in the Institution.

- Faculties shall have their short term and long term goals clearly defined and Percentage of achievement of the goals shall be reflected in the Performance Appraisal
- Faculties must utilize the strength of students in the research field/Consultancy like Unnat Maharashtra Abhiyan
- Center of excellence should develop Learning models for students. Faculties shall train students after college hours and 50% of the fees shall be given to faculty as remuneration.
- In addition finishing programs for enhancing employability shall be designed and implemented for all. Like, Mathematics-matlab, Mechanical-CAD,CAM, CAE, Piping Design, HVAC.. Electrical/Electronics-VLSI, Mobile communications, Embedded systems, Power electronics, IT-Cyber security etc...
- The high end softwares and instruments shall be applied in the research work and shall be open for use to all departments for promoting interdisciplinary research





