**Activity Report of Academic Year

- Defence Club of GCE Karad is established to provide a common platform to all the defence aspirants.
- In order to prepare defence aspirants to become officers in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard and CAPF. The defence club arranges various sessions for leadership training, defence examination preparation (CDS,AFCAT,INET,CAPF), Service Selection Board (SSB) interview training, self defence and adventure activities.

- **Republic Day Parade:**

30 cadets of the defence club had performed the parade on the republic day. This is the first ever parade performed by students in this institute.

- **Basic training of rope climbing and a one-day adventure camp:**

We train the cadets in various self-defence techniques like boxing, kick-boxing, etc.
